Greetings to everyone.

The year 2010 should be an exciting year as we select ways to enrich the lives of children and women. Please continue to find ways to interact with the children you come into contact with at school, home and church.

During the month of February our Hands on Project will be fulfilled at our Sudan Mission Study at Hopewell UMC in Anson County. We ask each UMW unit to provide kits for needy school age children. Each kit should contain the following school appropriate: 1) underwear, 2) socks and 3) belt. The kits will be delivered to schools or to Social Services in Anson, Stanly and Union County.

The March Hands on Project is Prayer Shawls and Baby Blankets and will be collected at the Prayer Breakfast (more details in the February newsletter). Each unit will be asked to participate. Suggested sizes are: triangle (65 inches long and 32 inches center back; rectangle (19 inches by 69 inches or 14 inches by 70 inches). The shawls and blankets may be sewn with fabric, knitted or crocheted.

I look forward to seeing each of you in February as we participate in the Mission Study.

Directions from Anson County:

Travel Rte. 742 to Kiker Road. Turn left on Kiker Road. In approximately ¼ mile, turn right on HOPEWELL Church Road.

Directions from Stanly County:

Go to Oakboro, take Rte. 742 to Substation Rd. (approximately 13 miles) Turn right. At the next stop sign and turn left onto HOPEWELL Church Rd. The church is approximately 1/4 mile on right.

Directions from Union County:

Take Walkup Avenue out of Monroe to Ansonville Rd. Stay on Ansonville Rd., crossing 205 and 218. After crossing 218 you will pass New Home Church Rd. which will turn into HOPEWELL Church Rd. Hopewell Church will be on the left. From Hwy.218, the church is located approximately 3.5 miles

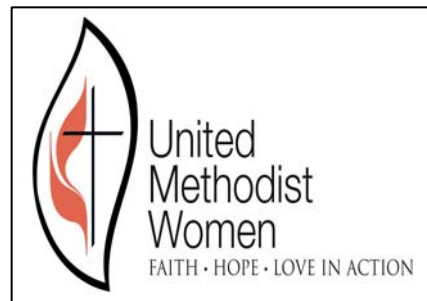
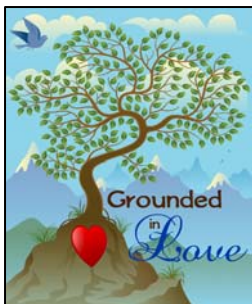

Housing for children 11 years old and under who are staying in the room with parents is free. Children ages 6-11 receive meals at half-price, children 5 years old and under receive meals free.
