



School of Christian Mission-FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

We are excited that you are coming to the School of Christian Mission! You are in for an outstanding learning experience! We hope this information will be helpful as you make your plans.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Pfeiffer University is located on US Highway 52 between Salisbury and Albemarle, NC.

From I-85 in Salisbury, take Exit 76 and follow US Hwy 52 South for 16 miles. The highway runs through campus.

From the eastern Charlotte city limits, you should travel US Hwy 49 North for 30 miles. At the intersection of US Hwy 52 and US Hwy 49 turn left. Campus is one mile north on US Hwy 52.

From Asheboro, NC, take US Hwy 49 South for 30 miles to the intersection of US Hwy 49 and US Hwy 52. Turn right on US Hwy 52.

From the Waynesville, Asheville, Hickory, Statesville area take exit 148 on I-40. You need to travel east on Hwy's 64/90. At the junction of Hwy 70, stay straight on Hwy 70 east. Travel approximately 25 miles and turn right on Jake Alexander Blvd. Travel 6 miles and right on Innes Street toward Hwy 52 South. Travel approximately 16 Miles. Pfeiffer will be on your right.

If you have a GPS system, enter Pfeiffer University, Richfield NC

Parking will be available in front of South Campus along Hwy 52 – look for signs. Register first then you will be directed where you need to unload your luggage. Local youth groups will be available to assist as porters for your luggage. Gratuities will be welcome and will go to assist them on their summer mission projects.

WHERE DO I GO WHEN I GET THERE?

Stokes Student Center is the place to start when you arrive. You will register first in **Stokes Student Center** located in the center of South Campus at the traffic light (#9 on the Pfeiffer University Campus Map) In **Stokes Student Center** you will find registration for all Classes. This includes full-time & commuter students, one-day overview students and teen students. Registration for Thursday, Friday and Saturday will be held in **Stokes Student Center**.

WHAT ARE SOME OTHER THINGS THAT I NEED TO KNOW?

A **RECEPTION** in your honor will be provided by the Winston-Salem District in **Stokes Student Center** for those registering on Thursday. They will have refreshments on Friday and Saturday for the one-day overview students.

Also in the **Stokes Student Center** you will find **PROGRAM RESOURCES** and the **DISCOVERY ROOM**. If you have any questions or if there is something you need help with, the **DEAN'S OFFICE** will be in **Stokes** too.

PARKING will be marked with signs, permits are required for "Visitor" and "Handicapped" spaces. You may park in any other marked space with no restrictions. We will have lots of signs to get you where you need to be.

The **SPIRITUAL GROWTH STUDY** will be held in the **HENRY PFEIFFER CHAPEL** (#18 on the campus map).
